Fourth/Fifth Grade Scope and Sequence

Fourth/Fifth Grade

1. Identify the basic parts of the computer.
2. Use proper log-on/log-off procedures.
3. Demonstrate the proper care and handling of equipment.
4. Use both hands on the keyboard.
5. Use the correct fingers to key the space bar and the return (enter) key.
6. Use mouse properly.
7. Introduce proper body posture.
8. Identify home keys and correct finger placement.
9. Use the correct hand to key backspace/delete.
10. Introduce proper keyboarding technique (sit up straight, curve fingers, wrists off frame).
11. Use the correct fingers to key the shift keys, tab, and backspace/delete key.
12. Begin to compose at the keyboard.
13. Instruct on home keys.
14. Become aware of finger placement on the alphabetic keys.
15. Apply keyboarding skill whenever possible.
16. Develop touch keyboarding techniques on the alphabetic keys and basic punctuation marks.
17. Develop and enhance the ability to compose at the keyboard.
18. Reinforce and further develop the skill of touch keyboarding.
