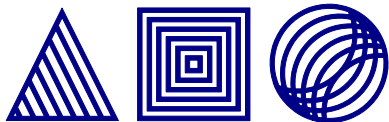

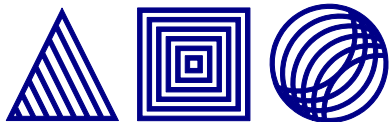

Second/Third Grade Scope and Sequence

Third Grade

1. Identify the basic parts of the computer.
2. Use proper log-on/log-off procedures.
3. Demonstrate the proper care and handling of equipment.
4. Use both hands on the keyboard.
5. Use the correct fingers to key the space bar and the return (enter) key.
6. Use mouse properly.
7. Introduce proper body posture.
8. Identify home keys and correct finger placement.
9. Use the correct hand to key backspace/delete.
10. Introduce proper keyboarding technique (sit up straight, curve fingers, wrists off frame).
11. Use the correct fingers to key the shift keys, tab, and backspace/delete key.
12. Instruct on home keys.
13. Become aware of finger placement on the alphabetic keys.
14. Begin to compose at the keyboard.
